



## **Kingston Park Academy Sport Premium Report 2016-2017**

In 2016/2017 Kingston Park Academy will receive the fourth year instalment of PE funding. The funding will be used in a variety of ways to further improve and develop teaching and learning across the whole academy. We will encourage pupils to continue to lead healthy lifestyles, enjoy PE and Sport and experience high quality teaching. They will be encouraged to take part in competitions and aim for sporting excellence. A Specialist PE coach has been employed as an integral member of staff. Their role has been the quality provision of PE Lessons, to ensure that children are making individual progress and that provision is consistent across time.

Having already seen impact of the funding from the previous 3 years we expect for this additional funding to have continued and sustained impact on provision of PE and sport within our academy. Participation by students and staff in whole school audits has resulted in the development of After Schools Clubs (including non-traditional) and purchase of equipment to enhance delivery of lessons. Thorough auditing and monitoring has meant that the children have had a role in developing sport and therefore has contributed to increased participation.
