## How can I help my child.....?

FS1	Sing nursery rhymes with your child and decide which character you wish to dress up as.
FS2	Next week is Nursery Rhyme week. Please ask us about the Nursery rhymes we are learning. Help us to read the words Mrs Carr and Mrs Barnes have sent home with us – these are our tricky words that we need to be able to read and spell.
Y1	Practise writing the alphabet using both UPPERCASE and lowercase letters. Continue listening to your child read, allowing them to sound out the words as they go.
Y2	Practise 2s, 3s 5s and 10 times table so that children can quickly recall problems involving multiplication. Look at the work set on Mathematics to improve their knowledge of addition and subtraction.
Y3	Remind your child about the importance of road & bike safety. Search for examples of contractions and conjunctions when reading at home.
Y4	Complete the 6 times tables tasks sent home with children.
Y5	Look at different timetables (e.g. bus, train) together and discuss what they show.
Y6	Help your children increase their ability to quickly recall timetables by testing them using the timetables sheet provided. Get them to explain to you the meaning of our word of the week (exhilarated). Get them to put it in a sentence which also contains brackets.
