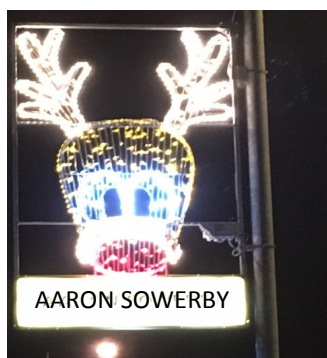

How can I help my child.....?

FS1	Can they sing you some songs from the nativity?
FS2	Please listen to us read our books and ask us questions about the story. Please help to read and write the tricky words on the list Mrs Carr has given you.
Y1	Practise the 2 times tables and ask children to sound out everyday words for objects, e.g. book b/oo/k and water w/a/t/er.
Y2	Some Year 2 children find reading to be their biggest challenge so please keep practising and reading at home.
Y3	Discuss all the learning that has taken place during our Greek workshop day and throughout our topic on Ancient Greece.
Y4	Help your child to find alternative words for deceived.
Y5	We will be writing instructions for a demonstration video. Could you please encourage your child to watch a demonstration video, thinking about the vocabulary used.
Y6	Ask them to share some of our words of the day and put them in a sentence for you. Ask them to show you how to subtract fractions.
