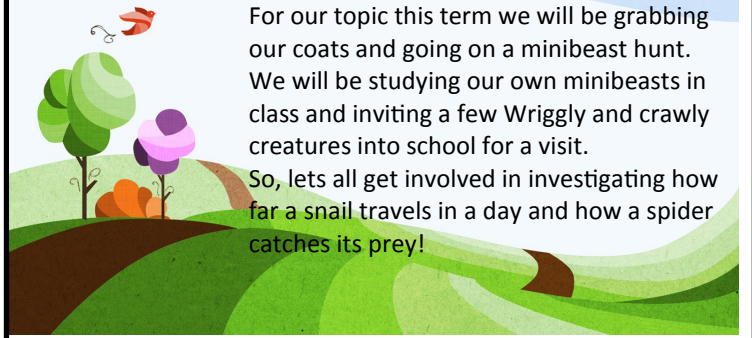
Year 1

As part of our topic this term Year 1 will be finding out about dinosaurs. We will become palaeontologists (a scientist who studies bones and fossils), find out amazing dinosaur facts and create a museum to show awesome artefacts. We are then going to visit a museum and become dinosaur detectives for the day.



Year 2

For our topic this term we will be grabbing our coats and going on a minibeast hunt. We will be studying our own minibeasts in class and inviting a few Wiggly and crawly creatures into school for a visit. So, lets all get involved in investigating how far a snail travels in a day and how a spider catches its prey!



Year 3

It's time to take a walk on the wild side! What will be discovered ... a bug-munching lizard or an eagle-eyed bird of prey? This half term, we'll study some amazing animals to discover how they move, behave and what they eat. Which ones are the predators/hunters and which ones will be the unwilling victims (their prey)? We will learn about creepy crocs, amazing alligators, the deadly assassin bug and the voracious Venus flytrap. Year 3 will then have the opportunity to go on a trip to the Yorkshire Wildlife Park.



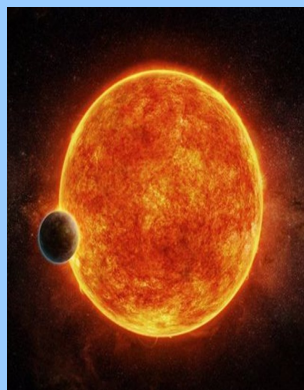
Year 4



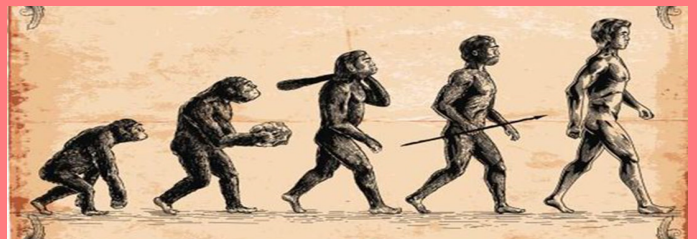
This term Year 4 are learning all about Roman warriors. We are going to be investigating what food they ate and then making some to try in class. They are also going to learn how to make Roman soldier puppets, their weapons and a stage to re-enact a historical Roman battle. Also as part of our topic we will have the opportunity to visit Mansfield Museum where we will handle artefacts, try on Roman costumes and take part in fun activities.

Year 5

For our topic this half term we will be finding out about our solar system! We will design and build rockets and space crafts, investigate what happens to liquid in the vacuum of space and preparing songs and rhymes to help us remember planets! Come with us as you get ready to journey with us through space.



Year 6



This term Y6 will be following Charles Darwin in his exciting expeditions on the HMS Beagle. We will explore how the unique animals of the Galapagos Islands helped him develop his theory of evolution by natural selection.
